Ampeleia 2007 sees the complete expression of a whole project that goes under the same name, Ampeleia.

This wine is the product of seven varieties from the hills around the town of Roccatederighi, and other areas of inland Maremma.

Ampeleia 2007 is the ambassador of style and character, moreover it is a vision not yet accomplished but in progress.

Ampeleia is the blueprint of a project of an extraordinary nature, which was inspired and is being developed by its three founding members, Elisabetta, Giovanni and Thomas. The concept behind the winery is based on variety and diversity (7 different varieties, different terrains and microclimates, as well as 3 different levels of altitude) and also on the interaction of various historical and contemporary components from the great Mediterranean wine culture.

Ampeleia's aim is to express the unique potential of its different terrains through viticulture and through a wine that encompasses this essence and diversity.
